TRENTON MAYOR ERIC JACKSON APPOINTS MR. LESLIE O. GRAHAM ACTING DIRECTOR OF INSPECTIONS

Trenton, N.J. — Mayor Eric E. Jackson today appointed Leslie O. Graham to Acting Director of Inspections, a position that is part of the Mayor's Cabinet. Mr. Graham starts his new role on Tuesday, September 8, 2015. Mr. Graham will go before City Council for advice and consent in the weeks ahead.

“As a former contractor licensed with the State of New Jersey as a construction official, building subcode official, building inspector, fire protection subcode official, fire protection inspector, plumbing inspector and mechanical inspector, Mr. Graham is eminently qualified, bringing three decades of proven experience to an important job,” said Mayor Jackson.

Mr. Graham has been a building inspector with the City of Plainfield since 2003. Previously from 1983-2003, he owned a construction company, Graham Construction, and from 1979-1982, worked as a carpenter with Plainfield-based Oxford Realty and Construction. He studied for his licenses at Middlesex County College in Edison and graduated from Union Catholic Boys High School in Scotch Plains.

The Department of Inspections' two divisions—Housing Inspections and Technical Services—oversee plan reviews, enforce rules, codes and regulations governing the use, occupancy, construction, alteration and maintenance of all properties within the city.
