Trenton Mayor Eric Jackson Will Deliver His State of the City Address on October 22

Trenton, N.J. — Mayor Eric Jackson will report to the people of Trenton on the State of the City this Thursday, October 22 in the Council Chambers at City Hall, city spokesman Michael Walker announced today.
