SUBJECT: Specifications Requirements for Multi-Cultural Holiday Display

Please note the following specifications must be followed for your Multi-Cultural Holiday Display:

1. The dimensions of your display must be between 3 x 5 and 5 x 7.
(Table or Floor)
2. The display should consist of:
 - Colors of your Country
 - Foods Eaten in your Country
 - Dance & Music – from traditional style
 - Ornaments, etc.
3. You must inform the office if you will be providing food on 12/21/11.
4. You must inform our office of your availability on 12/21/11 to render your interpretation of your display.
5. You must inform our office if you will have someone demonstrate the traditional dance or song of your country.

Please be reminded that all displays will be on exhibit from December 1, 2011 thru December 31, 2011. **We will not be responsible for valuables** left unattended, so please design your display accordingly.
