Statement from Trenton Mayor Eric E. Jackson Regarding the City's Water Quality Advisory

There has been intentional misinformation disseminated regarding the city's water quality advisory.

The water is safe to bathe in and use for laundry. It is very important that you get correct information about this issue from official sources, such as the city's website: trentonnj.org, and not from rumor or unidentifiable sources.

On Monday evening, we had a technical issue at the city's water treatment plant that caused chlorine levels to temporarily drop. Chlorine is used to help purify drinking water. Therefore, we advise those impacted to boil tap water for at least one minute until further notice.

We have activated the city's robocall system and updates are occurring on the City's webpage.
