## **TRENTON MAYOR ERIC JACKSON SWEARS IN SIX CABINET MEMBERS**

TRENTON, N.J. — Mayor Eric Jackson today swore in six members of his cabinet, including Francis E. Blanco, the first Latina Chief of Staff, and Jacqueline “Jackie” Foushee, a professional engineer and the first African-American female to head the city’s public works department in the history of Trenton municipal government.

“I am extremely proud of my team, and I am grateful for their service to me and to the people of Trenton,” said Mayor Jackson. “They are among the best thought leaders and implementers in New Jersey, and their skills and ideas will undoubtedly help me build a better city.”

In addition to Ms. Blanco and Ms. Foushee, the other cabinet members who were sworn in by the Mayor in the City Council Chambers on Wednesday afternoon included Terry McEwen as Business Administrator; James Brownlee, MPH, as Director of Health and Human Services; Monique King-Viehland, as Director of Housing and Economic Development; and David L. Minchello, Esq., as Director of the Law Department.
