Hazardous Weather

TRENTON: The National Weather Service has issued a winter storm warning affecting our area from 7 pm tonight until 3 am Thursday. This storm may produce snow accumulations in excess of 5 inches.

During previous snowstorms experienced in the City of Trenton, a number of vehicles have had to be towed off the roadways in order to make way for the snowplows to plow the streets. The Trenton Police Department would like to remind citizens that emergency snow removal is covered by City of Trenton Code 14-2.10, which states "Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street or highway, no vehicle shall be parked on the major roadways". This Code can be found in its entirety on the City of Trenton website under the "City Clerk" tab. A list of the major roadways is attached.

Residents who routinely park on the major roadways referred to in the city code are asked to be cognizant of potential weather conditions and to seek alternative parking solutions whenever the possibility of emergency snow removal becomes necessary. Residents may park in the listed school parking lots for the duration of the storm. When parking in the school lots, residents should park in a marked parking space, otherwise the plows will not be able to plow the parking lots and their vehicle may be towed, resulting in tow and storage fees.

The city will notify residents when to move their vehicles from public school parking lots using its "Robocall" or Emergency Notification System. However, all vehicles should be moved from the school lots by 3 AM Thursday. To learn more about the snow emergency routes and to register to receive notifications to a landline or cell phone number from this system, visit trentonnj.org. Owners of vehicles left in public school parking lots past 3 AM Thursday morning will be towed and the owners will be responsible for towing and storage fees.

Vehicles found on the major roadways in violation of the city code will be towed at the owner's expense. Towed vehicles will incur a towing and storage fee. A list of the major roadways is attached.
