



**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A 90-DAY CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH THE LIBERTY STORE, 5 EAST GENESSE STREET, AUBURN, NY 13021 FOR THE FURNISHING AND DELIVERY F.O.B. OF UNIFORMS AND FOOTWEAR TO VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND DIVISIONS ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,915.00

WHEREAS, Resolution Number 15-318 authorized a 60-day contract extension to The Liberty Store, 5 East Genessee Street, Auburn, NY 13021 from July 1, 2015 to September 30, 2015 for the furnishing and delivery f.o.b. of uniforms and footwear to various departments and divisions for the City of Trenton on an as needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton, Department of Administration, is in need of an additional 90-day contract extension from October 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015 for the completion of union negotiations, to allow for time to prepare new specifications, go out to bid and make a recommendation of award; and


WHEREAS, funds in an amount not to exceed \$12,915.00 have been certified to be available on an as needed basis in the following account numbers: 6-01--40-4030-303, 6-01--45-4000-303, 6-01--50-5000-303, 6-01--55-5500-303, 6-01--55-5510-303, 6-01--55-5520-303, 6-01--55-5530-303, 6-01-55--5540-303; 6-01--55-5500-841-002, 6-01--5500-851-003 and 6-01--70-7020-303 contingent upon adoption of temporary or final FY 2016 budget.



90 DAY CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH THE LIBERTY STORE

THE 90-DAY CONTRACT EXTENSION AGREEMENT made this 2ND day of October 2015, by and between the **CITY OF TRENTON**, a municipal corporation, of the State of New Jersey, with principal offices located at 319 East State Street, Trenton, New Jersey 08608 (hereinafter the "City") and **LIBERTY STORE** with principal offices located at **3 EAST GENESSE STREET AUBURN, NEW YORK, 13021** (hereinafter "CONTRACTOR")

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 13-583 awarded a contract to The Liberty Store for the furnishing and delivery F.O.B. of Uniforms and Footwear to Various Departments and Divisions for a period of one (1) year with an option to extend one (1) year on an as needed basis within the City of Trenton for a period of one year beginning September 6, 2013 through June 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 14-342 exercised the option to extend a contract for a period of one year commencing on July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 15-318 authorized a sixty (60) day contract extension due to union negotiations with the Liberty Store commencing on July 1, 2015 to September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 15-636 authorizes the City of Trenton a ninety (90) day contract extension with the Liberty Store commencing on October 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 for completions of union negotiations, to allow time to prepare new specifications; go out to bid and make a recommendations of award.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. The amount of the option to extend shall not to exceed \$12,915.00.
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a ninety (90) day contract extension with The Liberty Store, 3 E. Genessee St., Auburn, NY 13021 for said purposes in the manner prescribed by law.
