

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NUMBER 1 TO THE CONTRACT WITH PACT TWO, LLC FOR THE DISINFECTION UPGRADE PROJECT; COMPLETION OF WORK SHALL BE FOR 241 CALENDAR DAYS FROM NOTICE TO PROCEED IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,129.61

WHEREAS, Resolution 16-389 authorized a contract with Pact Two, LLC for the Disinfection Upgrade Project for the City of Trenton, Water Utility in the amount of \$3,736,274.00.00; and

WHEREAS, during the performance of the contract were discovered that additional work was required for this project; and

WHEREAS, the changes will not alter the contract in such a manner as to nullify the effect of the competitive determination of lowest responsible bidder which was made at the time of the contract award; and

WHEREAS, the amount of this change order is \$400,129.61. Previous change orders have been authorized in the amount of \$0.00. The total amount of this and previous change orders is less than 20% of the original contract amount; and


WHEREAS, funds have been certified to be available in C-06-13-55-019F-332 and C-06-18-55-019B-332;



**RESOLUTION # 19-169
CHANGE ORDER #1
BID2016-24**

THE AGREEMENT made this 19TH day of APRIL 2019, by and between the **CITY OF TRENTON**, a municipal corporation, of the State of New Jersey, with principal offices located at **319 EAST STATE STREET, TRENTON, NEW JERSEY 08608** (hereinafter the "City") and **PACT TWO, LLC, P.O. BOX 74, RINGOES, NEW JERSEY 08551** (hereinafter "CONTRACTOR")

WHEREAS, Resolution 16-389 awarded a contract on July 21, 2016, to Pact Two, LLC, P.O. Box 74, Ringoes, New Jersey 08551 for the Disinfection Upgrade Project in an amount not to exceed \$3,736,274.00 for the City of Trenton, Department of Public Works, Trenton Water Utility; completion of work shall be for 420 calendar days from notice to proceed; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. #19-169 dated April 18, 2019, authorized Change Order No. #1 in an amount not to exceed \$400,129.61 for the City of Trenton, Department of Public Works, Trenton Water Utility; completion of work shall be for twenty-four (24) calendar days from notice to proceed; previous change orders have been authorized in the amount of \$0.00. The total amount of this and previous change orders is 20% of the original contract amount; and

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. The amount of the agreement shall be in an amount not to exceed \$400,129.61. The changes will not alter the contract in such a manner as to nullify the effect of the competitive determination of lowest responsible bidder which was made at the time of the contract award; and
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized Change Order No. #1 with Pact Two, LLC, P.O. Box 74, Ringoes, New Jersey 08551 for said purposes in the manner prescribed by law. The grand total for this project is \$400,129.61.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

3. The amount of the agreement shall be in an amount not to exceed \$400,129.61. The changes will not alter the contract in such a manner as to nullify the effect of the competitive determination of lowest responsible bidder which was made at the time of the contract award; and
4. The Mayor is hereby authorized Change Order No. #1 with Pact Two, LLC, P.O. Box 74, Ringoes, New Jersey 08551 for said purposes in the manner prescribed by law.


WHEREAS, funds in an amount not to exceed \$3,736,274.00 have been certified to be available in account C-06-13-55-019F-332.
