RESOLUTION REJECTING BIDS RECEIVED FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF FERRY STREET BID2019-25

WHEREAS, three (3) sealed bids were received on May 4, 2019, for Reconstruction of Ferry Street NJDOT Trust Fund for the City of Trenton, Department of Public Works, Division of Traffic and Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the low bidder Richard T. Barrett Paving Company, Inc., 400 Prospect Street, Trenton, New Jersey 08618 submitted a sub-contractor who was not registered as a public works contractor at the time of the bid opening through the State of New Jersey Department of Labor, Division of Wage and Hour Compliance. Pursuant to P.L. 1999, c.238 (C.34:11-56.48 et seq), no contractor shall submit a sealed bid on any contract for public work as defined in section 2 of P.L.1963, c.150 (C.34:11-56.26) no contractor shall list a subcontractor in a sealed bid for the contract unless the subcontractor is registered at the time of the bid opening; and

WHEREAS, the bids received from the second low bidder, Earle Asphalt Company, P.O. Box 556, Farmingdale, NJ 07727 and third low bidder, Black Rock Enterprise, LLC, 1316 Englishtown Road, Old Bridge, NJ 08857 were over the engineer's cost estimate.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to reject all three (3) bids received and re-advertise this procurement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, by the City Council of Trenton that the bids received be rejected and the Division of Purchasing will re-advertise the procurement process.
