

# Lead Service Line Replacement Program

An important notice about lead in your drinking water from  
**Trenton Water Works**



**Trenton Water Works (TWW) records indicate that your home may have a lead or galvanized steel water service line. Galvanized steel pipes also contain lead.**

**Trenton Water Works has launched a Lead Service Line (LSL) Replacement Program. Over the next two years, TWW will replace at least 2,600 service lines throughout its service area at a reduced cost. The service line will be replaced with a lead-free copper service line.**

### Participation Options

## Why should I replace my lead service line?



**HEALTH:** Exposure to lead in drinking water may cause serious health problems including damage to the kidneys and brain. Infants, children and pregnant women are especially at risk.




**COST SAVINGS:** TWW has partnered with the State of NJ to secure funding for this important project. This program is an opportunity for homeowners to replace their lead or galvanized steel service line for \$1,000 or less. Once the service line is replaced, homeowners will pay for the replacement in installments for a period of a few years, depending on the Township's ordinance, through a special tax assessment on that property. The funding is limited and the cost may increase in future phases.

## What can I do RIGHT NOW?

- Install a water filter. Visit [twwleadprogram.com](http://twwleadprogram.com) for a list of water filters for your home. These filters remove 99% of lead at the faucet. 
- Sign up for the LSL Replacement Program. See the form on the front of this page.
- Flush your system by running cold water for approximately 1 to 3 minutes whenever the water in your home has not been used for more than 6 hours.
- Do not use hot water directly from the tap for cooking or preparing baby formula.
- Remove and clean faucet strainer to remove loose lead particles.
- Do not boil water for the purpose of removing lead.
- Replace old fixtures and faucets in your home with lead free plumbing materials.
