





presents the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR A CONTRACT WITH CARROLL GROUP INC, AWARDED FOR DEMOLITION SERVICES IN THE CITY OF TRENTON FOR DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF A 2 ½ STORY BRICK STRUCTURE DUE TO FIRE OPEN ROOF AREAS AND WALLS AT THE REAR IN A COLLAPSED STATE, LOCATED AT 129 CALHOUN STREET AVENUE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,420.00

WHEREAS, a need existed for the emergency demolition services of Carroll Group, Inc. at 129 Calhoun Street due a dilapidated structure as a result of a fire which created an immanent hazard to the surrounding environment; and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount for the contract is not to exceed \$40,420.00 and funds have been certified to be available in Capital Budget Year 2020, Account Number G-SS-20-60-111B-290, and

WHEREAS, these properties are privately-owned and after the required notice to the owners they failed to mitigate the hazard; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A.40A:11-6 provides that “[a]ny contract may be negotiated or awarded...without public advertising for bids and bidding therefore, notwithstanding that the contract price will exceed the bid threshold, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety and welfare requires the immediate...performance of services,” subject to the award being made pursuant to the manner set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the official in charge Henry Guarneri, Building Subcode Official, submitted the attached certification that an emergency existed, and that immediate services to remedy the emergency were required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer as follows:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a payment in an amount not to exceed \$40,420.00 to Carroll Group, Inc, 4 Youngs Road, Hamilton, NJ 08618 for emergency demolition services at 129 Calhoun Street in the City of Trenton.




2. This contract was awarded without competitive bidding as an emergency pursuant to N.J.S.A.40A:11-6 of the Local Public Contracts Law.
