ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 19-37 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CREATING SEASONAL POSITIONS, FIXING THE SALARY RANGE, THEREFORE, AND SETTING FORTH CERTAIN REGULATIONS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SAME"

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Trenton adopted Ordinance 19-37 entitled "an Ordinance creating seasonal positions, fixing the salary range, therefore, and setting forth certain regulations for the implementation of the same" on May 16, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton needs to update the salary range for seasonal laborer, therefore
 The City Council of the City of Trenton does ordain as follows:

1. That from and after the effective dates herein, the schedule below showing the salary range for seasonal laborer, be recognized as duly created and existing in the City of Trenton.
2. The salary range shall not exceed the minimum starting rate for permanent laborers.
