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Costs & Timeline Proposal

To offer simplicity and transparency in cost structure and to facilitate ease in accounting, we utilize flat rates, which apply regardless of the number of personnel assigned to your account. Based on the information provided in this request for proposal, we believe that approximately one hundred and sixty hours of combined work hours will be required to set up and properly train your twenty five team members.

- We propose a flat fee of \$16,000 USD for our service fee, which includes all research, setup, training time required by TeliApp. This is based on our \$100/hour fee for services, which applies during normal business hours, weekends and holidays.
- A separate \$125/hour fee will apply for any support services provided during non-normal business hours, weekends and holidays.
- The cost of the physical MFA security token, such as the Yubikey 5 series mentioned in the request for proposals will be charged at cost. The specific token utilized will be determined after consulting with City of Trenton stakeholders, executive management and its existing IT and/or InfoSec team. These devices can be purchased by TeliApp and then reimbursed to TeliApp by the City of Trenton, or they can be purchased directly by the City of Trenton.
 - For each team member as part of the pilot program, we recommend the purchase of four keys.
 - The first two physical MFA security tokens will be deployed as each team member is enrolled in MFA and trained to use them.
 - The remaining two tokens will serve as backups for each team member, should either of their MFA security tokens be lost, stolen or destroyed.
 - We also recommend purchasing an additional ten MFA security tokens to be used by your IT or InfoSec team, if they are not included in the twenty five executive staff mentioned in the request for proposals.
- We will be seeking reimbursement for gas and tolls from Linden NJ to Trenton when conducting in-person training (for one vehicle).
