## RESOLUTION REJECTING PROPOSAL RECEIVED TO PROVIDE CONSULTING SERVICES FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION SERVICES AND CONDUCT A PRESERVATION PLAN FOR ELLARSLIE MUSEUM RFP2024-24

WHEREAS, one (1) sealed Request for Proposal was received in the Division of Purchasing on September 5, 2024, at 11:00a.m. by the Purchasing Agent for RFP2024-24 for Consulting Services to Provide Historic Preservation Services and Conduct a Preservation Plan for Ellarslie Museum; for a period of one (1) year for the Department of Recreation, Natural Resources, and Culture; and

WHEREAS, the sole proposal received from Clarke Caton Hintz, P.C., 100 Barrack Street, Trenton, New Jersey 08608 in the amount of \$111,287.00. Pursuant to Local Public Contract Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2 allows the City of Trenton, Department of Recreation, Natural Resources, and Culture to reject proposals when the proposals received substantially exceeds the contracting unit's appropriation for services. It is in the best interest of the City of Trenton to reject this procurement and the Division of Purchasing will re-advertise at a later date.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, by the City Council of Trenton that the sole proposal received be rejected and the Division of Purchasing will re-advertise the procurement process.
